In partnership, Triangle Transit, the Towns of Wendell and Zebulon, and the City of Raleigh will offer a new weekday express bus route connecting Wendell and Zebulon with downtown Raleigh. Service is scheduled to begin October 26, 2009.

The Wendell/Zebulon-Raleigh Express (ZWX) is a limited-stop route. Stops include Park-and-Ride lots in both Zebulon and Wendell, WakeMed/Wake County Human Services off New Bern Ave, four stops at the state government complex, and Moore Square Station in downtown Raleigh.



The service runs at peak commute times (Monday-Friday 6-9am, 4-7pm). The fare for this route is **\$2.50 per one-way trip or \$5.00 per round-trip**. Discount fares and passes are offered. Several employers in downtown Raleigh offer free or discounted transit passes to employees. For more information, please visit triangletransit.org/bus/fares/.
